

Surprise your friends and family with the Gift of Theatre!


In keeping with the CCT theme for this season, the midwinter production will consist of 2 One-Act plays which have been presented in the past.




Artistic Call

Cranbrook Community Theatre's 61st Season of producing exceptional live theatre "for the community, by the community" begins October 2025.

We welcome interested teams to submit a production for the season.

Teams are strongly encouraged to have both a Director & Producer prior to submitting, however, all proposals will still be considered. Mentorship will be provided for inexperienced teams wanting to submit.

The deadline for proposals is Friday December 13, 2024 at 5pm MT





With more events than ever being held in the Studio Stage Door, the ability to offer everyone a seat had become an issue.

About 25 old wooden chairs were removed from the Studio Stage Door in 2019 to make way for other stacking chairs scavenged second hand from various places. The fabric was not the easiest to keep clean, the colours didn't match, but we maintained them for as long as we could until they too, began to break down.

Now, in 2024, we can finally say "here's your seat" thanks to the generosity of Rotarians from both Cranbrook clubs and a donation from the Jensen Family Foundation. Sixty sturdy chairs, that are easy to stack and clean (& they match!) have arrived and are now part of the venue's amenities.
